# **Executive Summary**

Opioid prescribing has become a complex pain management challenge. The challenge is compounded since most network providers are not formally trained in pain management or when to discontinue an opioid after therapeutic benefit has been reached.

When prescribing extends past the therapeutic benefit, unrelated costs impact members and the health plan. These costs can reach 15% of total plan cost annually (75% of these costs can be eliminated). Research also shows that 30% of members prescribed opioids are responsible for these costs. OPCM is the first, patent



pending, solution that can identify <u>clinical</u> Rx patterns of opioid prescribing by providers.

### Challenges

Health plans rely on analytic programs provided by their pharmacy benefit manger (PBM) to identify opioid <u>abuse</u> Rx patterns. These indicators identify members only after costs have been spent and lives changed.

### **How Product Helped**

OPCM identifies providers by clinical prescribing patterns and then OPCM pharmacists contacted those providers to validate or educate adoption of "best practice" for pain management prescribing.

## **Project Impact**

After 12 months, the *OpioidRx-AI*® reduced members incurring unnecessary cost due to opioid over prescribing 60.4%, saving the health plan almost \$1.45M. In addition, 98% of providers adopted CDC guidelines for opioid prescribing.
