## **Executive summary**

- Research shows 1 in 3 plan members prescribed an opioid painkiller will develop a dependency.
- Research also shows that plan members who become dependent to their painkiller prescriptions have 3X more healthcare encounters and are up to 7 times more expensive to the health plan.
- Opioid Clinical Management (OPCM) is the first patent pending solution that can identify <u>clinical</u> Rx patterns of opioid prescribing by providers that lead to dependency.
- Most opioid prescribers are not formally trained in pain management.

### Client Challenge

Health plans rely on analytic programs provided by their pharmacy benefit manger (PBM) to identify opioid <u>abuse</u> Rx patterns. These indicators identify members only after costs have been incurred and lives changed.

### How OPCM Helps

OPCM identifies providers by <u>clinical</u> Rx patterns, then OPCM pharmacists contacts those providers to validate or educate on the adoption of "best practice" for pain management prescribing.

### **Project Results**

OPCM helped this 10,000 member plan, after 12 month reduce by 75% the number of members incurring unnecessary costs due to opioid overprescribing, saving the health plan almost \$2.3 million. In addition, OPCM verified 99% of network prescribers had adopted, were adopting, or were receptive to adopting "best practice" CDC guidelines for opioid prescribing.
